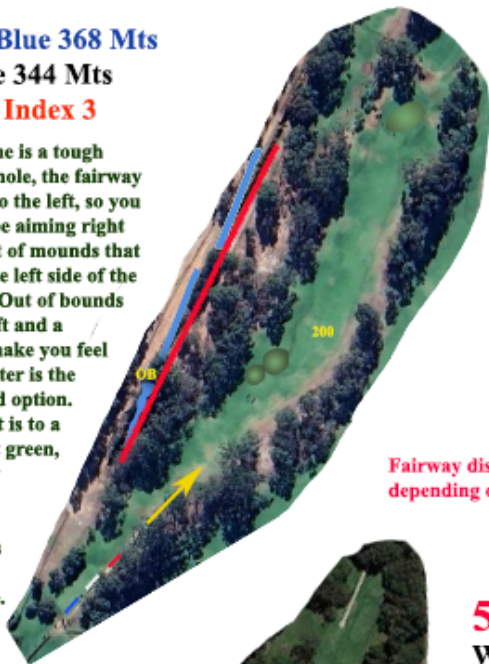


# Whaleback Golf Course

**1st Blue 368 Mts**  
**White 344 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 3**

Hole 1 one is a tough starting hole, the fairway doglegs to the left, so you need to be aiming right past a set of mounds that are on the left side of the fairway. Out of bounds on the left and a stream make you feel right center is the only good option. Next shot is to a large flat green, but early morning into the wind this is not an easy hole.



**2nd Blue 290 Mts**  
**White 278 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 14**

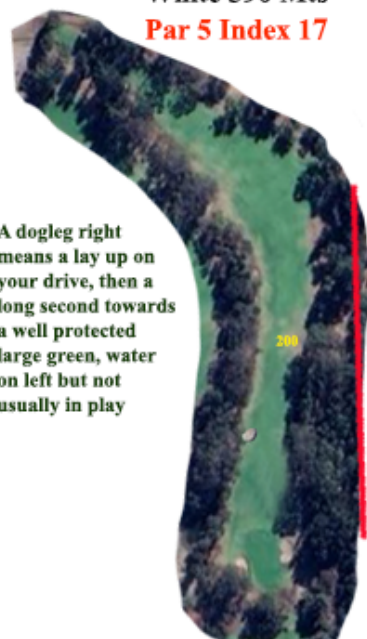
You must play this down the left side to open up the green, there is out of bounds on the left at the boundary fence and a stream behind but big hitters can get very close so an easy hole



Fairway distance may vary depending of tee box in use

**3rd Blue 405 Mts**  
**White 390 Mts**  
**Par 5 Index 17**

A dogleg right means a lay up on your drive, then a long second towards a well protected large green, water on left but not usually in play



**4th Blue 323 Mts**  
**White 313 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 9**

A short par 4 Slight dogleg right with a lake and large fairway bunkers on the right. A greenside bunker protects a large green



**5th Blue 295 Mts**  
**White 278 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 13**

A straight par 4 with a fairway bunker on the right and another near to the green on the left that only comes into play on your second shot. A bunker in front right of the green is a hungry fellow so plan to hit the back of the green where slopes help keep the ball in play



**6th Blue 171 Mts**  
**White 169 Mts**  
**Par 3 Index 6**

An easy par 3 but many will underhit because the water behind so hot long. to green with a split through the center.



**7th Blue 320 Mts**  
**White 300 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 5**

A dogleg left with out of bounds left will force you to aim right or center so that you can attack a green that slopes right to left and has a large bunker on the top side right of the green. A thinking golfers hole and tricky putting.



**8th Blue 165 Mts**  
**White 154 Mts**  
**Par 3 Index 12**

A fairly straight forward par 3 a large bunker on the right means that you should be aiming left side of the green.



**9th Blue 360 Mts**  
**White 348 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 4**

This front nine finishing hole is dogleg left and you need to approach from the left, a large placid green is unprotected but two good shots are required.



## Tees Explained

- Blue = Club Competition handicap used
- White or Yellow = Guests or Veterans
- Red = Youth or Ladies

**10th Blue 295 Mts**  
**White 288 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 15**

A tight tee box with out of bounds on the right and water on the left means aim center or left center is best, there are mounds on the right and the green is protected by two large bunkers left of the elevated but flat green



**11th Blue 463 Mts**  
**White 457 Mts**  
**Par 5 Index 8**

You must play this down the center, a tree in range about 180 out needs to be avoided, after this it is up hill all the way to a green that slopes right to left so accuracy on the fairway and a tough green makes this a hard hole.



**12th Blue 285 Mts**  
**White 272 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 16**

A nice downhill fairway from an elevated tee with out of bounds right but anything over 120 will run the ball down a sloping fairway towards new trees on the left, the green is protected by two bunkers in front but the green is narrow so hitting the green can be a challenge



Fairway distance may vary depending of tee box in use

**13th Blue 144 Mts**  
**White 132 Mts**  
**Par 3 Index 18**

A short par 3 across water with two tee boxes, green slopes from back to front and at the right, but a bunker on the left and anywhere near the left side will slope to the lake. Aim for the back of the green



**14th Blue 300 Mts**  
**White 388 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 2**

A long par 4 slight dogleg right with two trees about 140 out on the right that need to be avoided aim slightly left of the trees and then a long shot into a flat green, some mounds come into play and the driving range on the left is out of bounds.



**15th Blue 321 Mts**  
**White 311 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 10**

A straight par 4 with a tree on the left and bunker on the right means the landing zone is restricted, the green slopes from left to right making this a good putting challenge



**16th Blue 465 Mts**  
**White 438 Mts**  
**Par 5 Index 11**

A straight par 5 with some trees on the right of the fairway and several mounds to give you some interesting shots the left side can be quite sandy but center is your line all the way to a flat green



**17th Blue 380 Mts**  
**White 376 Mts**  
**Par 4 Index 1**

A dog leg left long par 4 two good shots to an elevated green that quite small



**18th Blue 155 Mts**  
**White 146 Mts**  
**Par 3 Index 7**

A trick par 3 when the tee box is back, water on the left and bunkers at the rear
